# The Simple Past Tense

O Simple Past Tense é usado para descrever uma ação que aconteceu no passado e que já terminou. Para mencionar esse tempo passado devemos usar expressões como:

Two years ago	Dois dias atrás
Last Year	Ano passado
Last week	Semana passada
Last month	Mês passado
Last night	Noite passada
Yesterday	Ontem
In 2017, etc.	Em 2017, etc.



Geralmente há duas classificações para os verbos em inglês no passado: verbos regulares (regular verbs) e verbos irregulares (irregular verbs). Os verbos regulares recebem a terminação **-ed**. Analise uma lista dos principais verbos regulares:
